Stage 1:

A bidder will be disqualified if the enterprise fails to achieve the above-mentioned minimum threshold for local production and content and if the declaration certificate for local content MBD 6.2 annexure C, D and E is not submitted together with the tender documentation. **Only local produced or manufactured cables with the above threshold for local production and content will be considered.** The Exchange rate to be used for the calculation of production and content will be the exchange rate published on South African Reserve Bank at 12H00 on the date of this tender advertisement and only the South Africa Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 1286:2011 must be used to calculate local content.
